

Human Physiology and Anatomy Teaching Laboratory (318):

This laboratory is located on the third floor of the department building and contains several models of all body systems, along with workspace for the required experiments. The lab has a capacity of 25 students per practical session.

In this laboratory, the practical part of the Human Physiology and Anatomy course is taught. This course aims to connect anatomy with the function of the human body's systems to understand the relationship between function and structure in the physiological integration of body systems to maintain homeostasis. The following systems will be studied during this course: nervous, circulatory, lymphatic, digestive, respiratory, and urinary systems. The course focuses on the mechanisms of converting signals into responses at the molecular level.
