Themes

The general theme of this contest is "Physics is both science and art". Use your inspiration and feelings to express "physics" concepts in a creative/artistic way (photo, video, wallpaper, poem, song, story, game, caricature, show/play) in one of the following 3 categories:

Quantum (Knowledge/Technology), Light (Knowledge/Technology), or Physics in general (i.e., any other fields).

Requirements

- 1- The competition is open to anyone at the University of Jordan. Participation from outside the university is also welcome.
- 2- Registration through the participation form is mandatory.
- 3- Individual and Team participations are both welcome. For team participation, the number of participants must not exceed three, and one participant must be registered as a principal participant.
- 4- Participation in more than one category is allowed, provided that the participant submits a separate participation form for every category.
- 5- All participations must be original work and have not been submitted before for any other competitions.
- 6- Any participation that does not fulfill the above requirements will not be considered for evaluation.

Prizes and Certificates

- Prizes will be awarded for the best participation in every category.
- Certificates of participation will be given to all participants.
- Prizes and certificates will be awarded at a special ceremony of "10-year Anniversary of LAMBDA".
